#### 2. What type of customer buys EOS / Amarr 2448?

Homeowners & commercial building owners seeking a door with a hard-to-find smooth flush, contemporary appearance, that combines sleek style with energy efficiency and proven performance.

## Product Details

**1. What is the exterior texture & design?**

The door has a smooth flush design that is smooth as ice. There is no exterior embossment.

**2. What colors are available?**

Black and White

**3. Are the doors paintable?**

Yes, however field painting voids the factory finish warranty. See link for field painting instructions: [Amarr Field Paint Instructions](#).

**4. What is the thickness and insulation?**

Doors are 1-3/4" (4.5cm) thick with foamed-in-place polyurethane insulation.

**5. What is the R-value of these doors?**

The R-value is 13.5.

**6. What bottom seal and retainer are used?**

Bottom panels have an L-shaped aluminum retainer with a black vinyl T-slot weather seal.

**7. What Residential windows are available for the EOS?**

SlimLine 41" x 7" insulated windows are available in clear, frost, and dark tint in either black or white frames.

**8. What Commercial windows are available for the Amarr 2448?**

Three commercial black frame windows are available: 24"x8" & 24"x12" insulated tempered, and 26"x13" insulated acrylic.

**9. What is the current wind load offering?**

IBC wind load certification is available up to 140 MPH through 16'4" widths without windows. Florida Building Code (FBC) certifications are pending and will be official by December 18, 2024.

**10. What is the Residential warranty for the EOS ES3134?**

Residential doors carry a 25-year finish warranty and a 5-year warranty for both sections/delamination and workmanship/hardware.

**11. What is the Commercial warranty for the Amarr 2448?**

Commercial doors carry a 10-year finish warranty. The section/delamination warranty is 5-years and the workmanship/hardware warranty is 1-year.

**12. How can the doors be cleaned?**

Simply wipe down with a cloth and soapy water.
